NEW VISITATION REGULATION

California Department of Public Health

Issued December 31, 2021

COVID-19 VIRUS & VARIANTS

- As COVID-19 outbreak continues to pose a severe threat to California, more people resort to COVID-19 vaccinations to prevent infection and severe disease.
- California is currently witnessing the pandemic's fastest spike in COVID-19 infections, with 18.3 new cases per 100,000 persons per day.

DELTA VARIANT

The Delta variant, which is extremely contagious, is currently the most prevalent variant in California, accounting for the majority of new infections throughout the state.

OMICRON VARIANT

Early data also suggest the increased transmissibility of the Omicron variant is two to four times as infectious as the Delta variant, and there is evidence of immune evasion.

Note: Unvaccinated individuals are more prone to contract the virus and spread it through the air.

COVID-19 OUTBREAK & PREVENTION

- California's health care system is currently able to deal with the increase in cases and hospitalizations due to vaccinations and actions implemented since March 2020.
- The majority of current hospitalizations and deaths occur among unvaccinated individuals.
- This drastic spike in the number of cases led to more statewide facility-directed regulations being needed to protect vulnerable groups.
- COVID-19 outbreaks in adult and senior care residential facilities can result in hospitalization, serious sickness, and possible death.

According to California Department of Public Health (CDPH), While COVID-19 transmission is increasing in California, immunization is the most effective way to prevent new infections, transmission, and outbreaks.

NEW REGULATION ON VISITATION


COVID-19 continues to be a public health problem, and in order to avoid its spread in adult and senior care residential facilities, visitation requirements and temporary public health standards are in place. This is to limit the risk of transmission from visitors that may bring the COVID-19 virus within the facility.

For **indoor visitation (vaccinated and tested)**, verify visitors are vaccinated, have had all recommended booster doses and provide evidence of a negative SARS-CoV-2 test within one day of visitation for antigen tests, and within two days of visitation for PCR tests; OR (2) permit only **outdoor** visitation for those that do not meet all the requirements


For **outdoor visitation (tested)**, visitors must provide evidence of a negative SARS-CoV-2 test within one day of visitation for antigen tests, and within two days of visitation for PCR tests.

NEW REGULATION ON VISITATION

- 1. In Adult and Senior Care Residential Facilities (licensed by the California Department of Social Services) unvaccinated, incompletely vaccinated, or booster-eligible visitors who have not yet received their booster dose are eligible only for outdoor visitation if they can show documentation of a negative SARS—CoV-2 test where the specimen collection occurred within 2 days if using PCR or 1 day if using antigen testing before each visit and for which the test results are available at the time of entry to the facility.
- Such persons must also wear a well-fitting face mask (a surgical mask or respirator) and
- Physically distance from facility personnel and other patients/residents/visitors that are not part of their group at all times during the visit.







NEW REGULATION ON VISITATION

If a resident is not able to leave their room or otherwise meet with visitors outdoors, the visitation may take place indoors, even for visitors who cannot provide vaccine verification or a negative test; however, these visits cannot take place in common areas, or in the resident's room if the roommate is present, and the visitor must wear a well-fitted mask with good filtration (N95, KF94, KN95, or surgical masks are preferred over cloth face coverings) and the resident must wear a well-fitting face mask at all times and physically distance.

For visitors who visit for multiple consecutive days in all settings covered by this Order, proof of negative test is only required every third day (meaning testing is only required on day 1, day 4 and day 7, and so on).

WHAT ARE THE EXEMPTIONS FROM VACCINATION AND TESTING REQUIREMENTS?

- 1. Visitors who are visiting a patient in critical condition, when death may be imminent.
- 2. In emergent situations, support persons for a patient with physical, intellectual, developmental disability, or cognitive impairment.

For subsequent visits following the emergent situation and as soon as reasonably possible thereafter, but no longer than 72 hours, these visitors must comply with the vaccine verification or applicable testing requirements.

TO SUMMARIZE


(Effective on January 7, 2022 - February 7, 2022)

VISITORS MUST:

1. Provide **BOTH** proof of full vaccination with booster status **AND** evidence of a negative COVID-19 test (taken 1 day (24 hours) of visitation for antigen tests, or 2 days (48 hours) of visitation for PCR tests).

2. Wear a well-fitting mask with good filtration (N95, KF94, KN95, or surgical masks are preferred over cloth face coverings)

CAREGIVER PETITION COST

EB-3 Immigrant Visa Processing of Caregivers

From \$11,500 to \$7,500.

(Save \$4,000 or 35% discount if you are a 6Beds PPM)

The immigration lawyer services covers:

- 1. PERM (Permanent Employment) application with the Department of Labor,
- 2. Form I-140 immigrant petition with USCIS and
- 3. consular processing with the Department of State.

CAREGIVER PETITION COST

The attorney fee does not include the filing fees and costs for the processing. The breakdown are as follows:

- Approximately \$1,000 to \$1,700 for PERM advertising
- \$200 for credential evaluation
- \$700 for I-140 filing (USCIS)
- \$2,500 for premium processing (optional, USCIS)
- NVC fees and medical expenses:

\$345 immigrant visa fee to the NVC

Approximately \$200 for medical exam fees

\$220 immigrant fee to USCIS for greencard production

ESTIMATED TOTAL COST FOR ATTORNEY FEES AND FILING FEES, AND PROCESSING PER EMPLOYEE: \$12,000

CAREGIVER PETITION COST

If the candidate has family members who will be immigrating with him or her, there is an additional attorney fee of \$500 per family member
