# Behavioral Health Bridge Housing (BHBH) Program

- The California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) will provide a total of \$1.5 billion in funding
- to county behavioral health agencies and Tribal entities to operate bridge housing settings
- to address the immediate housing needs of people experiencing homelessness who have serious behavioral health conditions, including serious mental illness (SMI) and/or substance use disorder (SUD).

# Independent Living Providers

Rental assistance for a total of 89 individuals at the rate of up to \$2,800/month for a contract of up to 6 months (average)

Benefit:

- License not required if you are not providing care services.
- Provide 3 meals a day and housekeeping

# Assisted Living Provider s (ARF & RCFE)

## Ancillary Funding for Assisted Living

Serving a total of 74 individuals at a rate of \$3,400/month supplemental for a contract of up to 6 months (average)

## Participant Assistant Funds

Providing 120 individuals with a budget of up to \$1,000 used to remove barriers and support people with behavioral health conditions who are also experiencing homelessness to meet their immediate housing needs.

# Landlord Outreach and Mitigation Funds

The Landlord Incentive Program Fund shall provide landlords \$2,000 per individual as an incentive for placement in permanent housing.

# Recent Develop- -ments

- Medi-Cal recipients maybe eligible for Assisted Living benefits
- Rates will Depend on Contract Negotiations

- Community Transition Services/ Nursing Facility Transition to a Home
- Personal Care and Homemaker Services
- Environmental Accessibility Adaptations (Home Modifications)
- Medically Supportive Food/ Medically Tailored Meals
- Sobering Centers
- Asthma Remediation
